This is a class for children like the following (※They must be enrolled in the public elementary school of Itabashi Ward)

- For children who have come to Japan from abroad and are learning Japanese for the first time.

- For children who have returned from abroad and want to understand Japanese and the curriculum, or who are almost capable of daily speaking but feel anxious about acquiring academic language.

Distinct characteristics of the class

① Special support class based instruction .

- Enrolled in an ordinary class, students learn in this class on specified days and times .

- For special support classes, guardians must drop off and pick up their children from other schools.

- The enrolled class will be regarded as attended.

② Individual/small group instruction .

- We create a tailored curriculum for each student and provide individualized instruction accordingly.

- While individual instruction is our principle, group instruction may also be included if necessary.

- We will devise study methods based on each child's interests and developmental level and provide guidance for acclimating to the Japanese language.

③ We consider conjunctions important.

- To support children in having an amicable school life, we work in conjunction with other schools. We contact the school's teacher in charge to check each child's current condition.

- At the beginning and end of summer vacation, we visit the school to observe each child's status and plan opportunities to talk directly with the teacher in charge.

- We will also have opportunities to communicate with guardian about the condition in every class.

- We are preparing reports about the progress of each semester and sending them to the guardian and the teacher in charge.

④ We will do our best for mutual understanding of cultures.

We will provide opportunities to engage with Japanese culture, discuss, and introduce the child's culture, fostering appreciation for both cultures .

※The special support class is primarily 2 hours each session . In addition , the duration of the special class will generally be 2 years.

We are following these instructions.

【The goal of the class】

- ① To improve Japanese language skills (speaking, listening, writing, and vocabulary comprehension) necessary for daily communication and understanding school classes.
- ② To learn about Japanese customs in school and daily life, as well as Japanese culture, and to adapt to living in Japan.
- ③ To understand both Japanese culture and the culture of the home country, fostering a sense of respect.

【About the Instruction Content 】

- ① Survival Japanese → Learning essential phrases for daily life and greetings.

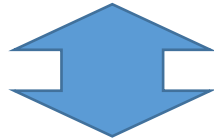
(Example)

- ・健康で衛生的な生活を送る → 「おなか／頭がいたいです」 など
- ・安全な生活を送る → 「危ない」「だめ」「赤は止まれ(信号)」など
- ・周囲の仲間との関係をつくる → 「ありがとう」「これ、かして」「いいよ」「まって」など
- ・学校の生活を円滑に送る → 教科名、場所、学校生活で特に必要な表現など
- ・あいさつ、返事、自己紹介など



- ② Basic Japanese → Learning fundamental knowledge and skills of the Japanese language.

・ Instruction in pronunciation, letters and markings, vocabulary , and sentence structure.



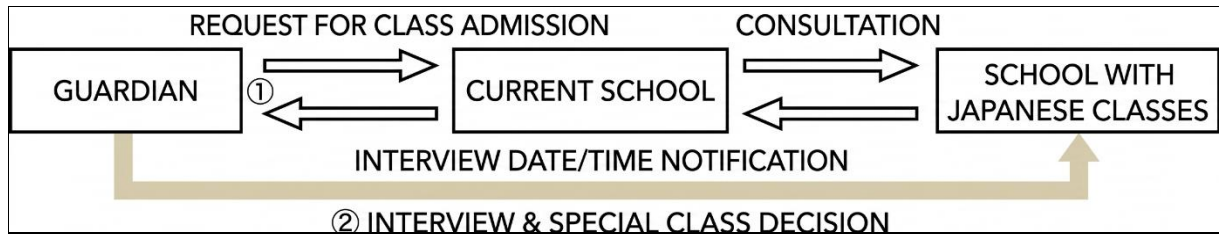
- ③ Support for Learning Curriculums → This will help students confirm the language they are learning and understand the content of the curriculum.

We usually focus on the content of the Japanese language subject; however, subjects such as math and sociology may be included if necessary. We will develop teaching methods tailored to each individual, such as translating into the mother tongue or using simple Japanese.

About the Schedule ※The following outlines our principal, but we conduct our classes according to the schedule of the enrolled school.

The Process of the Special Support Class



① Enrollment Request

Submit an 「enrollment request」 to the principal of your enrolled school. After that, the teacher from your school will contact you regarding the interview schedule at the established school (Shingashi Elementary School).

② Attend the interview at the established school (Shingashi Elementary School) at the designated time. To assess the child's progress in learning Japanese, we ask both guardians and the child to be present.

During the interview, we will confirm the special support class system and the desired date of enrollment, deciding based on the interview results.

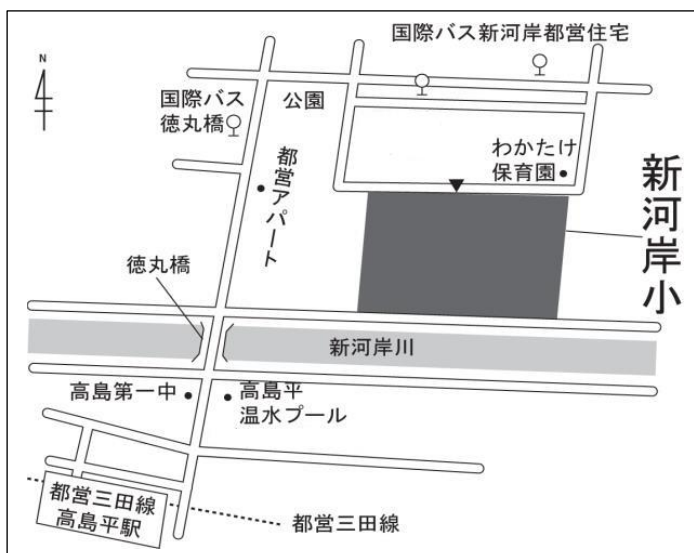
The final details will be conveyed to the teacher of the enrolled school and the guardian.

Points to Note for the Special Support Class

- There is no charge for studying in the Japanese class (No class fee).
- For children commuting to the special support class who receive assistance with school attendance, the transportation fee to attend the Japanese class will be paid in advance and refunded later. The transportation fee for guardians is the responsibility of the guardian.
- Lunch will be eaten at the enrolled school.
- If your child is absent from the special support class, please contact both the enrolled school and Shingashi Elementary School.
- Guardians are responsible for ensuring their children's safety during their travels to and from school.

(Children will be accompanied to and from school by a guardian or someone designated to replace them.)

Access to Shingashi Elementary School



- 12-minute walk from Takashimadaira Station on the Toei Mita Line
- From Ukimafunado Station on the Saikyo Line, take a bus bound for “Tobu-Nerima Station” and get off at “Shingashi Toei Jutaku.” It is a 1-minute walk from the bus stop.
